Naima will personally welcome you at the villa.




The journey takes about **1h to 1: 30h**.

From the airport, head north and follow the **signs to Los Llanos**. You are led up the hill and through the **tunnel**. Then you drive down the sunny side of the island (beware in El Paso: there is the only **radar** on the island with 50km/h).

**Before** Los Llanos take the exit for **Tijarafe / Tazacorte** at the **roundabout** and follow the signs to **Tijarafe**.

You will be led into a valley and then on **serpentes** up a 450m high mountain. There is the **viewpoint "El Time"**. We invite you to park the car for a few minutes and enjoy the view for a few minutes.

**Continue** on the road for about **500m**.

On the **left you see a supermarket sign**, as well as a **street** that branches off to the **left**. Turn left here. Go **downhill past the supermarket**, follow a long left turn and here, at the end of this long turn, **take the second right into Camino de la Callejeta**.

This road is easy to recognize, it seems straight and heading towards the sea. After two bumps, after the yellow house on the **left, there is a hidden, small path** on the left. There should also be a wooden **sign with "Villa Govinda"**. Drive (slowly) down this very small, concrete path. You are at the parking lot of Villa Govinda. Naïma should welcome you here. We wish you a nice stay.
